

PRIVACY POLICY

1. Introduction

This privacy policy is drawn up in compliance with art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR).

This privacy policy intends to describe how this website is managed , with specific regard to the personal data processing of the Users who visit the website, directly or via external links.

This privacy policy has been issued for the website www.blrm.it only and is not meant to be applied to the other websites possibly visited by the User through the links on the pages of the aforementioned website.

The purpose of this website is to provide information to the public on the activity of Biolato Longo Ridola & Mori Law Firm.

This website does not contain advertising spaces or advertising insertions from third parties.

2. Data Controller and place of data processing

The website www.blrm.it is run and controlled by Biolato Longo Ridola & Mori Law Firm – office in Rome, via Ludovisi 35, 00187 -, the “Data Controller” of the personal data herein gathered.

The User shall be entitled to exercise the rights set out in the GDPR and to raise questions, requests, comments with regard to this privacy policy or the data processing methods to: Biolato Longo Ridola & Mori - Studio Legale Associato, attention to Avv. 3. Type of data processed

The website collects the following type of data:

i) Navigation data and cookies

The IT systems and the software procedures for the operation of this website, collect some personal data from the browser of the User whose transmission is implicit while using the Internet communication protocols:

- IP addresses, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses, including the time of the accesses, the numeric codes and the files uploading;
- URL (Uniform Resource Locator) data, which identify the resource requested from the User (websites, images and documents) including the date and the time of access.

No personal data of users is intentionally acquired by the website. Neither cookies nor the so-called persistent cookies of any kind or any users' tracking systems will be used for the transmission of personal information. The use of the so-called session cookies (that are only temporarily recorded on the user's computer and that are deleted as soon as the browser is closed) is strictly limited to the transmission of session IDs (made up of random numbers generated by the server) necessary to perform a safe and efficient exploration of the site. The so-called session cookies used in this site avoid any recourse to other IT techniques that are potentially prejudicial to the privacy of the users' navigation and do not allow the collection of personal data which may identify users.

ii) Data voluntary provided by the User

The website sometimes requires or may require the User to provide personal data – name, surname, domicile, telephone number and email address – which shall be provided only voluntarily by the User.

Specifically, the users that wish to send their CVs through the website www.blrm.it are invited to pay the due attention to the processing of data related to them and inserted in the CVs sent, pursuant to what is provided in this privacy policy.

The Users that are planning to send their CVs are pleased not to include sensible data (i.e. personal data allowing the disclosure of racial or ethnic origin, religious, philosophical or other beliefs, political opinions, membership of parties, trade unions, associations or organizations of a religious, philosophical, political or trade-unionist character, as well as personal data disclosing health and sex life), which cannot be lawfully processed without the previous consent of the User – pursuant to art. 9 of the GDPR – that it is currently difficult to obtain through the web.

iii) Data provided by third parties

This website reserves the rights to process personal data contained in public lists – i.e. data banks, professional orders, telephone books, etc.- which can be object of specific processing in compliance with the GDPR and in particular the provisions set forth with regard to unsolicited communications – performed by SMS type message, mail or email-.

4. Purposes and methods of the data processing

4.1 The personal data acquired by the website will be processed by Biolato Longo Ridola & Mori Law Firm for the following purposes:

- to allow the full functionality of the website, including the update of the contents and the access to reserved areas;
- for the technical working of the website and the informatics system;
- for the communication with the Users including requests of opinion and researches on the contents of the website to which the Users are allowed whether or not to adhere.

4.2 Personal data may be processed through manual, telematics or informatics means and in any case in full compliance with the GDPR and the provisions set forth with regard to the protection and security of the personal data.

4.3 The personal data processing is carried out by the Data Controller and by the People in charge of processing.

4.4 Personal data shall not be communicated to third parties nor divulged without the previous consent of the User except when required by the law, i.e. a) upon request of the Judicial Authority; b) when required by the need to protect the rights and the security of the Users or in general of third parties.

5. Legal basis for personal data processing

Pursuant to point (f) Article 6 (1) of GDPR, the legal basis for the personal data processing is in the legitimate interest of Biolato Longo Ridola & Mori Law Firm, to provide, through this website, information to the public on its activity.

6. Retention of personal information

Personal data shall not be stored beyond the period strictly necessary for the purposes pursued as previously stated and in accordance with the law.

7. Personal data diffusion and profiling

Personal data are not subject to diffusion or to decisions based exclusively on automated processing, including profiling.

8. Rights of the Users

8.1 The User shall have the right:

1. to obtain from the Data controller,
 - a) the access to personal data and information;
 - b) the correction of inaccurate personal data and the completion of the incomplete personal data.
 - c) in the circumstances provided for in Article 17(1) of GDPR, the erasure of personal data concerning him or her;
 - d) in the circumstances provided for in Article 18(1) of GDPR, the restriction of the personal data processing.
2. Under the circumstances provided in for Article 20 of GDPR, the User will have the right to receive the personal data in a structured format, that is commonly used and machine readable and, subsequently, to transfer these data to another entity (right to request data portability).

8.2 The User shall also have the right:

1. to object, under certain circumstances, to the personal data processing;
2. to withdraw his consent at any time, when the personal data processing is based on point (a) of Article 6(1) or point (a) of Article 9(2), without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal;

3. to claim with the competent data protection authorities (Autorità Garante per la protezione dei dati personali – www.garanteprivacy.it).

9. Security of the information

Biolato Longo Ridola & Mori Law Firm has adopted a security system of the personal data collected in order to prevent the unauthorized access and/or use of the data collected from third parties.

Biolato Longo Ridola & Mori Law Firm shall not be in any case liable for any unauthorized access, loss of data, unlawful/incorrect use, alteration of the personal information that may occur outside its control, and cannot grant the correct and safe use of the personal data of the User by third parties.

10. Modification of this privacy policy

Biolato Longo Ridola & Mori Law Firm shall provide to update regularly this privacy policy in order to reflect the needs, suggestions and requests of the Users.

Therefore, you are invited to verify regularly this privacy policy in order to be informed of the updated data protection methods of your personal information from the Data Controller.
